Data Privacy Notice

Personal data relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data. Identification can be by the information alone or in conjunction with any other information in the data controller's possession or likely to come into such possession. The Northern Ireland Squirrel Association is the data controller and decides how personal data is processed and for what purposes. The processing of personal data is governed by the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).

The Northern Ireland Squirrel Association complies with its obligations under GDPR by keeping personal data up-to-date; by storing and destroying it securely; by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data; by protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data.

The Northern Ireland Squirrel Association uses personal data for the well-being and development of all its members and for the following purposes:

- To enable the provision of a voluntary service for the benefit of all its members throughout Northern Ireland
- To administer membership records
- To manage members of volunteer Leadership teams
- To maintain accounts and financial records (including the processing of Gift Aid applications)
- To maintain records/reports in accordance with Charity Commission reporting requirements
- To inform of news/events/activities

Sharing personal data

Personal data will be treated as strictly confidential and will only be shared with other members of the Northern Ireland Squirrel Association with consent in order to carry out the services outlined above.
