## Orienteer Activity Badge



# Scouts

5 mins	Welcome Opening Ceremony
10 mins	<p>Tonight we will be looking at working towards our orienteering badge, We will be teaching our scouts to orientate their map to the surroundings .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Have a pre drawn birds eye view of the room you are using including everything in the room.</li> <li>* Use this as template to demonstrate how to orientate your map.</li> </ul>
30 mins	<p><b>Main Activity</b>– Have the scouts draw their own maps of the room and decorate their own markers. They should then mark a location on their map they want to hide their marker. Pass the maps to different groups and have them try to find the marker. This will help with orientation which is part of the badge.</p>
10 min	<p><b>Fun game</b>-Mark out a big X and O's box, line 2 teams adjacent to each other each armed with bean bags. The objective is for one team to get 3 in a row of their chosen letter. Only one person from each team may go at a time allowing the next person to go once the pervious person has returned. To lengthen the game, make the participants do something on there way to the box for example, to dance, do 10 star jumps, sing a song.</p> <p><b>Equipment:</b> rope/tape for the box and bean bags.</p>
